SUBJECT: Healthy Families Program Advisory Panel Vacancies

The Managed Risk Medical Insurance Board (MRMIB) is seeking applications for individuals to fill vacancies on the Healthy Families Program (HFP) Advisory Panel. The Advisory Panel was established to advise the Board on policies, regulations, operation, and implementation of the HFP. The HFP is a state and federal subsidized children's health, dental, and vision insurance program for children in low to moderate-income families. The program was implemented on July 1, 1998, and it is currently insuring more than 850,000 children.

The Advisory Panel is comprised of 15 members who serve three-year staggered terms on a voluntary basis. They are compensated for necessary travel expenses. In addition, Advisory Panel members representing subscribers are provided with compensation of \$100.00 per meeting. The Advisory Panel meets quarterly and the meetings are usually from 10:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. in Downtown Sacramento. The next scheduled meeting is Tuesday, August 9, 2011, in Downtown Sacramento. MRMIB is seeking representatives for the following category:

1. Subscriber with a Child in Healthy Families;
2. Subscriber with Special Needs Child; and
3. Disproportionate Share Hospital Provider;
